



Vincenzo Damiano PANDOLFO was born March 28, 1986 in Lentini (Syracuse).

He joined the Italian Army in 2005 as volunteer and after attending the first training in Chieti (Abruzzo), in 2006 he was assigned at Army Training Center Aviation in Viterbo (Lazio).

In 2007 he was assigned at Bersaglieri "Garibaldi" Brigade as infantry rifleman in the 1st Bersaglieri Regiment. He participated in 2008, 2009 and 2012 at ISAF Mission in Afghanistan for a six months tour. He participated also at operations in the national territory to maintain security during the G8 meeting in 2009 in L'Aquila (Abruzzo) and at operation "Strade Sicure" in Crotona
