



Mario Ciccotti joined in the Italian Army in 2004 as a cadet of the Modena Military Academy and started his studies in chemistry and pharmaceutical technology.

After two years he was nominated officer, and until 2011 he attended the Academy where he received his commission as a pharmacist of the Italian Army's health corps.

His first job has been in Rome in the Italian military hospital "Celio" as a pharmacist who followed as his first assignment in the medical devices section.
